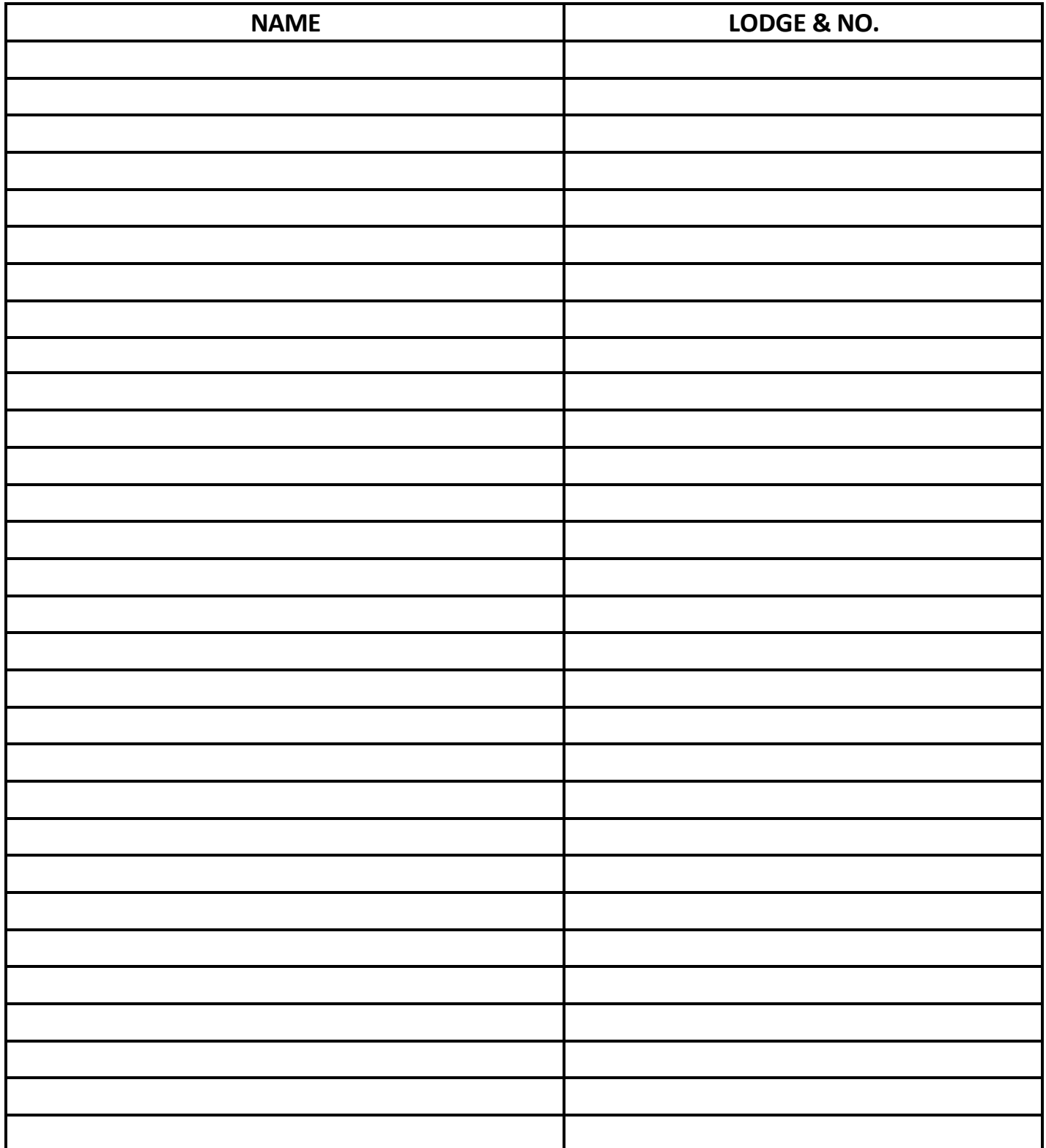
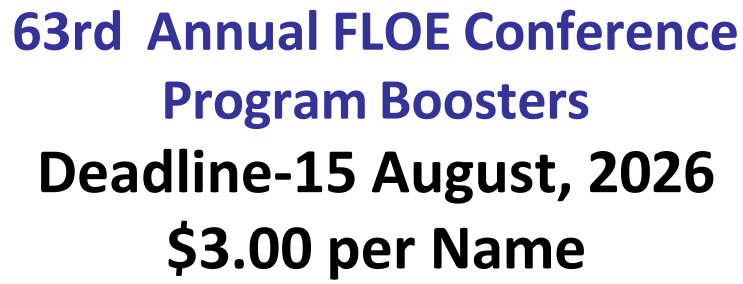

63rd Annual FLOE Conference Scrapbook and Yearbook Competition Guidelines



Size of scrap books shall not be more than 12x12 inches or less than 8x8 inches. Any sizes between the aforementioned is acceptable.

1.) Contents of each entry will be judged on creativity, organization, presentation, and completeness and must contain the following items at a minimum:

- Title page must include the name of your Ladies Organization, Lodge number affiliation, address district and your club year dates.
- List of your Ladies Organization Officers and Chairpersons, names are sufficient, no contact information is required.
- List of FLOE State Officers and your District FLOE Delegates.
- History of colors and purpose of your Ladies Organization
- Oath of your Ladies Organization.
- Schedule of meetings of your Ladies Organization.
- Each page must have event information and date somewhere on the page.
- Journaling should provide meaningful information about the subject/activity and should be on each page or set of pages.

2.) The cover/contents must be sturdy of construction and should stand up to much handling in the future.

3.) Entries should only include data for the Ladies Organization year listed on the title page. You may include the Installation of Officers for the Organization Year even though the Installation occurred prior to your year starting.

4.) All materials shall be entered chronologically by month

5.) Entries will be judged based on the following:
